Early Childhood Support

ParentLink provides information, support, and strategies to help parents identify challenges at their most solvable point.

ParentLink guides parents through developmental screenings to help them track their child's development, from



birth to age 6, then follows up afterward to share results and information that may be beneficial.



Kinship Family Support

KIN-4-KID Line

ParentLink's Kinship Program supports caregivers who are raising children who are not biologically their own, including grandparents, relatives, foster parents, and others. The program helps caregivers connect with information, programs, and supportive services for the children they are raising as well as for themselves.

ParentLink's Access Navigators help individuals overcome barriers and fully connect with needed resources that improve family health and wellbeing. Some examples include:

Filling out applications like:

- » Medicaid
- » Food Stamps (SNAP)

- Temporary Assistance (TA)

Helping you find:

- » Transportation
- » Home visiting programs
- » Housing

Services for Incarcerated Parents

ParentLink connects to incarcerated parents and their families through Parenting Corners, displays of parenting materials and resources available in family visiting rooms of 18 correctional facilities in Missouri. Inmates fill out cards to mail to ParentLink with questions and concerns.
